Beer

Here at The Bohemia we genuinely believe the heart of a great pub is amazing beer. We currently sell ale brewed on our brew kit on site and beer brewed at our sister pub The Bull, Highgate. We brew beer on site so that we can direct control of the most important product we provide for you. We hope that this will encourage you to enjoy the passion that we have for this amazing beverage.

As well as brewing real yet adventurous beer on site we aim is to give you as much choice as possible from around the world. We have pilsners and IPAs from Colorado to Bavaria. If you need help with choosing a beer (or two!) then just ask one of the team and they'll be happy to suggest something.

Food

We couldn't sell great beer without having some great food to match. Our food menu has been designed to complement our vast drinks menu. From classics such as fish and chips to American inspired crafted hot dogs made especially for us with our best bitter, Beer Street. Brewery

London Brewing Co was founded the same time as the Bull, July 2011 delivering a wide variety of delicious ale on a regular basis to the patrons of Highgate. The 3 barrel (bbl) brew kit, located in our kitchen at the Bull, was ideal for refining our recipes to the tastes of the emerging beer aficionados of North London. Once we saw the Bohemia we knew it would be an ideal place to house an even bigger brewery. Building on the experience and the feedback we had we begun to craft recipes which would suit our larger 6 bbl brew kit here. The ability to brew up to 2000 litres daily means that not only are we small enough to be flexible with our flavours but also big enough to meet greater demands if needs be. We are really looking forward to taking your taste buds on an adventure over the coming years in North Finchley.
